

## **P.V.M.H.A. EXECUTIVE MEETING**

Bill reported that Pembina Valley will be hosting 8 provincial tournaments this year. This will put a real strain on our referees, since all referees are to be Level III and linesmen Level II. The provincial banners and medals were handed out to hosting centers.

The Regional Novice tournament went well with Manitou and Somerset hosting. There were 13 teams participating broken down into three divisions, gold, silver and bronze.

The gold medal game in the gold division saw Morden 1 defeat Winkler. The bronze medal game was between Notre Dame and Portage 2 with Portage 2 coming out on top.

The silver division saw Manitou 2 winning gold over Morden 2 and the bronze game was Portage 1 losing to St. Claude.

The bronze division saw Rock Lake 1 defeating Holland and the bronze game was won by Manitou 1 over Prairie Hills.

Rock Lake 2 was also playing in the silver division. Suggestions for another year was awarding this tournament earlier in the year for teams to plan ahead and get more teams attending.

Hockey Manitoba is looking after sending out all the letters this year regarding our year end programs and there will be only one Female tournament, that being the POE in Swan Lake just before spring break.

The male POE is for kids 15 years old, the Directors Cup is for kids born in 1989. Pembina Valley will have about 3 or 4 development camps. The Pee Wee skills camp for players born in 1991 will have one camp in Oak bluff and one in Shilo.
