

**PEMBINA VALLEY MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION
SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 18, 2006
MIAMI COMMUNITY CENTER**

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm.

Roll Call was done and all associations were present with the exception of Gretna.

Vince/Merv to adopt the minutes of the Annual meeting held April 15, 2006 as posted on the website. All in favour. Carried.

BUSINESS ARISING:

There was discussion at the Annual meeting regarding allowing the female teams from Eastman into the league and everyone was reminded that this was passed.

Pembina Valley will be setting up a development fund and charging 20.00/team extra that will go into this fund. It will be used in a variety of ways including to help cover travel expenses for teams going North.

The changes to the constitution that were proposed have been implemented and a copy of the constitution will be distributed when available.

Each association is reminded that bonds are now 150.00 and are due October 15, 2006 at the scheduling meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

REGISTRAR:

Bill Lawson has reminded everyone to have their association's contact sheet filled out and handed to Lisa Sibbald by the scheduling meeting October 15, 2006. He noted that some changes have been made to the handbooks and any changes are highlighted in the book. Tournament sanctions **MUST** be in to Bill 3 weeks prior to tournament. Bill stressed the need for rosters to be turned in to him before any of the teams start playing games. If a team roster hasn't been approved, they **ARE NOT** insured. All transfer requests should go into Bill Lawson and all overage applications are approved/denied by Bill Whitehead.

Bill provided some clarification regarding the Y/N portion of the roster sheets that the parent fills out and signs. If a parent circles the N, they **DO NOT** consent to their child's name being printed publicly. This would include printing of name in tournament programs etc.

REF-IN-CHIEF:

Brent Smart talked briefly about the changes coming into effect this year. There is a zero tolerance regarding stick infractions. He noted that it will mean a lot of penalties until the players/coaches adapt to the new rules. A video is available from Hockey Manitoba that outlines these changes very clearly. Each association is encouraged to get one of these videos. If everyone is properly educated on these changes, it will help ease the transition for everyone. Every association will be expected to comply with these new rules. There is a meeting set for October 2, 2006 for all associations Chief Referees that will enable them to be informed of all changes. All referee clinics are posted on the Pembina Valley Minor Hockey Association website (www.pvmha.com). Referee evaluation forms will be distributed to each association who will be responsible for evaluating their own officials.

COACH MENTOR:

Brian McElroy was introduced to everyone as the new coach mentor for Pembina Valley. He noted that if anyone is interested in having him attend practices &/or games, they are encouraged to get in touch with him and he will be more than happy to come out.

DEVELOPMENT CO-ORDINATOR:

Jim noted that the “speak out” program is now included with the coach clinic but is not included with the initiation program. “Speak out” will be available to take on-line. All clinics etc. are posted on the Hockey Manitoba website and registration can be done through the website. Jim reminded everyone that all coaches must be properly certified by December 1, 2006.

League play starts November 4, 2006 and ends on February 11, 2007.

Development week is February 2 – 4, 2007. Any individuals interested in coaching the Director’s Cup, Female Challenge or Male Bantam Development teams should submit their resume to Doug Orchard by December 30, 2006.

Manitoba Moose 50/50 draws were awarded to Morden for November 11th and Rosenort for November 25th.
